

You Have Options!

Act 1 This class will be focused on all the core concepts you need to know to be comfortable and successful on stage! Movement, projection, creating your character are among the things you will learn. In addition you will get to practice your craft with scenes and improv! Whether this is your first year, or you're a seasoned actor, there's always more to learn and this class will help you hone your skills. **Grades 6-12.**

Act 2 This class will be focused on Character Development, Script Analysis, and bringing greater depth to your character. This class is for experienced actors who have attended previous years of Acting Lab or have equivalent experience and want to really study the craft.

If you think you might be interested, check the box on your Acting Lab application. Come to the first class prepared to audition with a one minute monologue. In order to get the most out of this experience enrollment will be limited. **Grades 6-12.**
